Convention Resolutions

Resolution 3. Concerning Proposed Brentswood Development Project

Whereas, the citizens of Prince William County have faced unbridled development to the detriment of our natural resources, quality of life, and response times by our fire and rescue squads;

Whereas, the addition of 6,800 homes encompassing 1,500 acres of land in an area already challenged by the crowds attending events at Nissan Pavilion across the street, this project will have a negative impact that it will extend to the region far beyond the Nissan Pavilion;

Whereas, the Brentswood project is not necessary to obtain critical funding for transportation improvements as proffer money proposed by the developer in exchange for approval of the project could otherwise be procured from existing federal and state earmarks for transportation improvements for the I 66/RT 29 interchange;

Whereas, the Republican Party supports environmental stewardship and quality of life issues and a project of this size and scope will adversely affect these matters;

Therefore, be it resolved that the Prince William County Republican Committee urges the Prince William County Board of County Supervisors to oppose this project on behalf of the citizens living in PWC now, and

Be it further resolved that the Board of County Supervisors provide the required services for the homes already approved before they add new burdens to the taxpayers of Prince William County.
